Graduate students in the first semester attend compulsory from six core courses, three days a week that are common to all directions and trained in Medical Research Methodology, Technology and Communication. Continuous monitoring and participation in all courses and internships (26 credit hours per course, 5 ECTS per course, 30 ECTS semester).

In the second semester the students attend compulsory from six core courses, three days a week that are common to all directions and trained in Medical Research Methodology, Technology and Communication. Continuous monitoring and participation in all courses and internships (26 credit hours per course, 5 ECTS per course, 30 ECTS semester).

In the third semester each student selects a number from a list of specialized seminars and/or Medical Research Methodology workshop, the sum of which should be at least 15 ECTS. The seminars and workshops will be 3 or 4 or 5 x2 hrs which will have the corresponding ECTS. At the same time begins the dissertation and collecting material of thesis 15 ECTS. 30 ECTS semester.

In the fourth semester they are related to a Unit of the Medical School, they attend and participate in the work and research carried out by the supervisor and prepare thesis subject to evaluation. 30 ECTS semester.

Courses are held in the afternoon, three times a week. The internship, as does the research work of the fourth semester are made after consultation with the supervisor, in hours of work units.
